Dear Mr Jankowski

It is with great attention that I read your letter dated 6th April regarding your inquiry on the future of the plot of land located in Warsaw at 132 Ractawicka Street. It is interesting for me to learn more and more on the Polish culture and history, also the one related to sports and the city of Warsaw.

The letter left me with an impression that there is a need to clarify certain facts.

It is correct that Frontex, the European Border and Coast Guard Agency, has been promised the ownership of part of the big plot located at Ractawicka Street in Warsaw. The transfer of the ownership has not yet happened as the respective agreement to that end is pending ratification by the Polish Parliament.

The part offered to Frontex does not cover the area of the football field or the old stadium. The owner of the whole plot (covering the area in question) remains to be the Polish State Treasury, and the plot is administered by the Ministry of the Interior and Administration.

From my perspective the Polish administration is much better positioned to respond to your questions regarding any recultivation plans for this area, especially with regard to the possible functions of the plot as specified in the draft master plan - sporting facilities.

Having said that I would like to assure you that local community matters, promotion of pro-public developments for the benefit of our young generations, as well as promotion of health by sports, are very close to me.

Not being in the position to make any commitments or promises, I would like to inform you that I have authorized Ms. Sabine Kloss-Tullius, Head of the Financial and Corporate Services Unit, to answer any remaining concerns on this subject.
